Section 2

#2 * Having the ability to let go while living in community is huge. Example: You may be convinced that your way of doing whatever is by far the best way but others might not think it is. Do you feel you can let go and still work with others without being angry. (we do not expect anyone to not have feelings about this but being able to let go is necessary in any successful group situation.)

#5 * Community living successfully is like living part time in a personal growth workshop. We are trying to recreate connections, sustainability and personal growth/awareness. This first comes with human connection and is a very important foundational building block of our community.

#9 * Religious proselytizing and or fundamentalism is not acceptable here.

Many of these questions are to bring awareness to you of what you will experience here. We try to screen visitors but some do not answer questions honestly and then come here. You will be asked to leave very quickly if you become a problem within the community. We are willing to give most people a chance to change but not at the cost of harmony within the community. If you expect communities to be problem free and everyone living in harmony 100% of the time you will be disappointed.
